## WHAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR?

Our venue is Brighton Fringe's first ever Grassroots Digital Art Venue. We consider Digital Art as content which is designed specifically for the digital realm

- Pre-recorded or designed (Not Live). 20 mins or more (Max 3 hours) or containing a series which accumulates to at least a 20 minute viewing experience.
- We encourage applications from all genre and styles of digital art. This can include genres, although not exclusively, such as film, interactive film, experimental film and audio, Radio Play, Immersive Audio, E - Galleries, Zoom dramas, VR/XFR and web series, do it at home audio dramas, puppetry, Sketch and anything that hasn't been digitally dreamed up yet.
- We will accept Digital Adaptations of Live stage productions
- We will not accept filmed recordings of live stage productions unless a consideration of the digital experience has been considered.

## ARTISTIC OBJECTIVES

#### The Living Record Festival aims:

- To support independent companies, storytellers and artists to make the move into the digital sphere.
- To programme work which is purpose built for a digital platform i.e. an interactive zoom show, choose your own adventure book, immersive audio play, short films or an e-gallery of digital happenings
- Curate the identity of several individual digital spaces with a variety of pieces guided by the audience, supporting the artist.
- Present a provocative and entertaining broad church of experience, encouraging quality expressive engagement with the platform and the possibilities/confines of the website.



## WHAT WILL THE FESTIVAL BE LIKE?

The Living Record Festival is a month-long Digital arts festival curating and presenting original pieces from a range of art forms by independent companies and freelance artists.

- A space for audiences to connect, review and experience affordable work from the digital sphere.
- Supported professional development, networking and artistic experimentation for artists and storytellers at all career levels.
- A financially accessible marketplace for theatre companies to connect with audiences and the wider arts industry.



### THE PLATFORM

- The Living Record Festival will be hosted by a virtual space which speaks the language of the theatre. The website will contain 'spaces' for the work of our partnered companies where audiences can explore, watch, listen and experience.
- The platform will also include shops for merchandise, a notice board for reviews and the ability to search and browse material via categories or genres. The Workshop space hosts LIVE webinars, workshops and classes and you can join the crowd in the Bar for digital scratch performance, poetry, play readings and live music.

# ARTISTIC OFFER

- PARTNERS: The companies and artists we work with on this platform will be termed as a partner. This definition is important to us as it articulates our belief in the work and commitment to representing the company through robust, creative and collaborative marketing strategies.
- **LOW RISK:** We believe our offer to companies and artists minimises (financial risk) risk from producing Digital art whilst maximising the opportunity to earn profit from trading material online and connecting with audiences in the future. - **CREATE YOUR OWN SHOWFILE:** Through creating an Interactive space for the User and one that allows you to manage your own marketing via sales reports and to adapt your own microsites accordingly. The microsite will serve as a direct and comprehensive hosting of you/your company throughout the duration of the festival.
- **GIFTING:** Features such as gifting and instant audience reviewing incentivise word of mouth giving your piece the best chance of becoming an internet sensation. Gifting is a key part our accessibility ethos a system which discount the price of each ticket as user gift to another person they know. When the ticket reaches its fifth gift it will become free content and the user will be encouraged to share with person who cannot regularly access theatre or is most likely to never consume art.
